# Executive Summary

The Graduate Employability Survey 2024 conducted by Eastern University, Sri Lanka (EUSL), provides a comprehensive overview of the employability landscape among graduates from EUSL's faculties, Trincomalee Campus, and Swami Vipulananda Institute of Aesthetic Studies (SVIAS). This annual survey, conducted during the convocation period, serves as a pivotal tool for assessing employment trends, response rates, and graduates' readiness for the job market. Furthermore, we did not include Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) graduates in this survey as they apparently have 100% employment rate.

Faculty-specific employment rates vary widely, with Faculty of Agriculture, Faculty Arts and Culture, Faculty of Commerce and Management, Faculty of Health-care Sciences (Nursing Degree), Science, and Faculty of Technology are reporting 53%, 25%, 80%, 100%, 86%, and 17% employment rate respectively. Also, the Faculty of Applied Science, Faculty of Communication and Business Studies, and Faculty of Siddha Medicine from Trincomalee Campus are reporting the employment rates of 80%, 64%, and 53% respectively. Furthermore, Swami Vipulananda Institute of Aesthetic Studies has a 45% employment rate.

The duration of job-seeking time is a critical factor in evaluating graduates' employability. This survey, conducted during the Convocation period, invited all eligible graduates—regardless of their degree's effective dates—to participate. The findings reveal notable variations in the interval between the degree's effective date and the convocation date. For graduates from the Faculty of Commerce and Management, Faculty of Science, and Faculty of Arts and Culture, the interval exceeded one year for 85%, 82%, and 51% of graduates, respectively. In contrast, 100% of graduates from the Faculty of Technology had intervals of less than three months. Among graduates from the Faculty of Health-Care Sciences (Nursing Degree), 89% reported intervals of 7 to 9 months, while 74% of graduates from the Faculty of Agriculture experienced durations of 10 to 12 months.

At the Trincomalee Campus, 47% of graduates from both the Faculty of Applied Science and the Faculty of Communication and Business Studies reported intervals of 10 to 12 months and 7 to 9 months, respectively. Meanwhile, 45% of graduates from the Faculty of Siddha Medicine had intervals exceeding one year. 96% of graduates from the Swami Vipulananda Institute of Aesthetic Studies reported an interval of 10 to 12 months between the effective date of their degree and the convocation date.

The response rate for this was notably low, with only 35% of the 2,090 eligible graduates participating. While the Faculty of Commerce and Management achieved an impressive response rate of 93%, other faculties recorded significantly lower participation. The Faculty of Applied Sciences in TC, had the lowest response rate at just 12%, followed by the Faculty of Technology at 23%. This disparity highlights a need for improved engagement strategies to ensure more comprehensive data collection and more representative insights into graduate employability. The poor response rate limits the ability to draw fully accurate conclusions, emphasizing the importance of addressing participation barriers in future surveys.

This report underscores the importance of targeted educational reforms and strategic career guidance to enhance graduate employability across all faculties. It provides valuable insights for university stakeholders, policy-makers, and employers aiming to bridge the gap between education and the evolving job market.

# Employability Survey

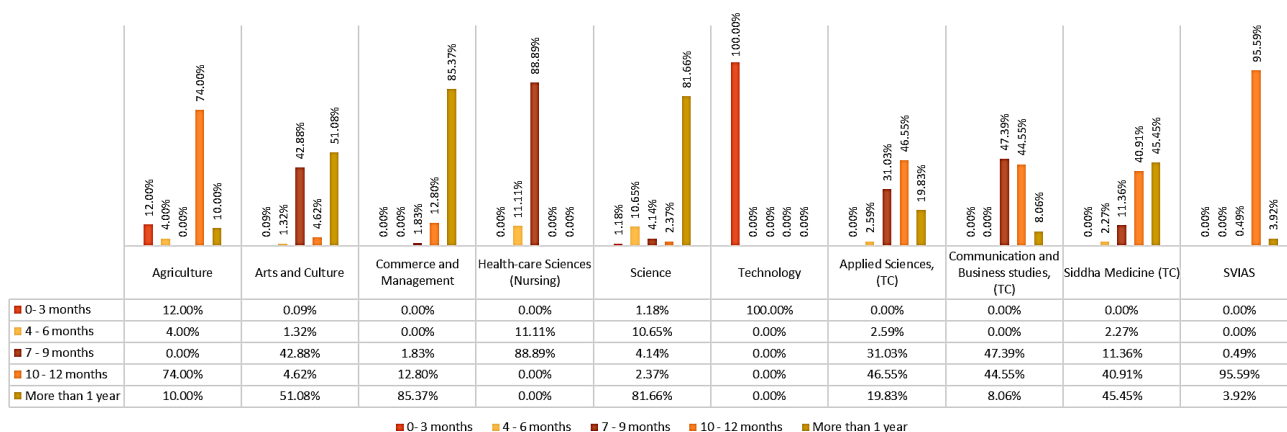

This report is prepared based on the responses from the graduates in all faculties of Eastern University, Sri Lanka, Trincomalee Campus (TC), and Swami Vipulananda Institute of Aesthetic Studies (SVIAS).

The period from the effective date of the degree to the General Convocation is considered the duration to find a job. Based on this assumption this survey report has been prepared.

## Response Rate

The census of the graduates included six faculties in EUSL, 3 faculties in Trincomalee Campus and Swami Vipulananda Institute of Aesthetic Studies. As it could be seen from the table below, from all the 2090 graduates, 739 responded to this census. The highest response rate (93%) was from the Faculty of Commerce and Management, and overall 35% of graduates responded to the census.

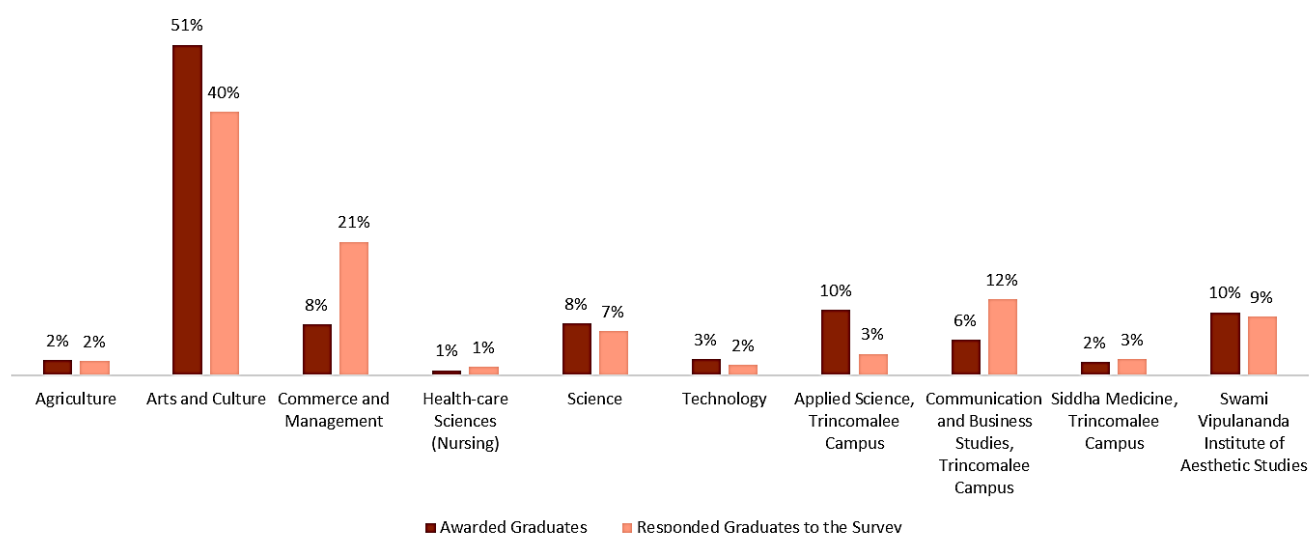

Among the graduates who were awarded degree at the General Convocation held in October 2024, the majority (51%) were from the Faculty of Arts and Culture. Faculty of Applied Sciences, TC and SVIAS were next with 10%. While 8% were from Faculty of Commerce and Management and Faculty of Science. Among the total only 6% were from Faculty of Communication and Business Studies, TC and 3% from the Faculty of Technology; 2% were from Faculty of Agriculture and Faculty of Siddha Medicine, TC; only 1% were from Faculty of Health-care Sciences.

The highest response rate received from Faculty of Commerce and Management, it's around 93%; following to this Faculty of Communication and Business Studies, TC has 75% response rate for this employability survey. Meanwhile, Faculty of Applied Sciences, TC has the minimum response rate of 12%. Overall, 35% of response rate was received for this survey, this rate is not a good rate

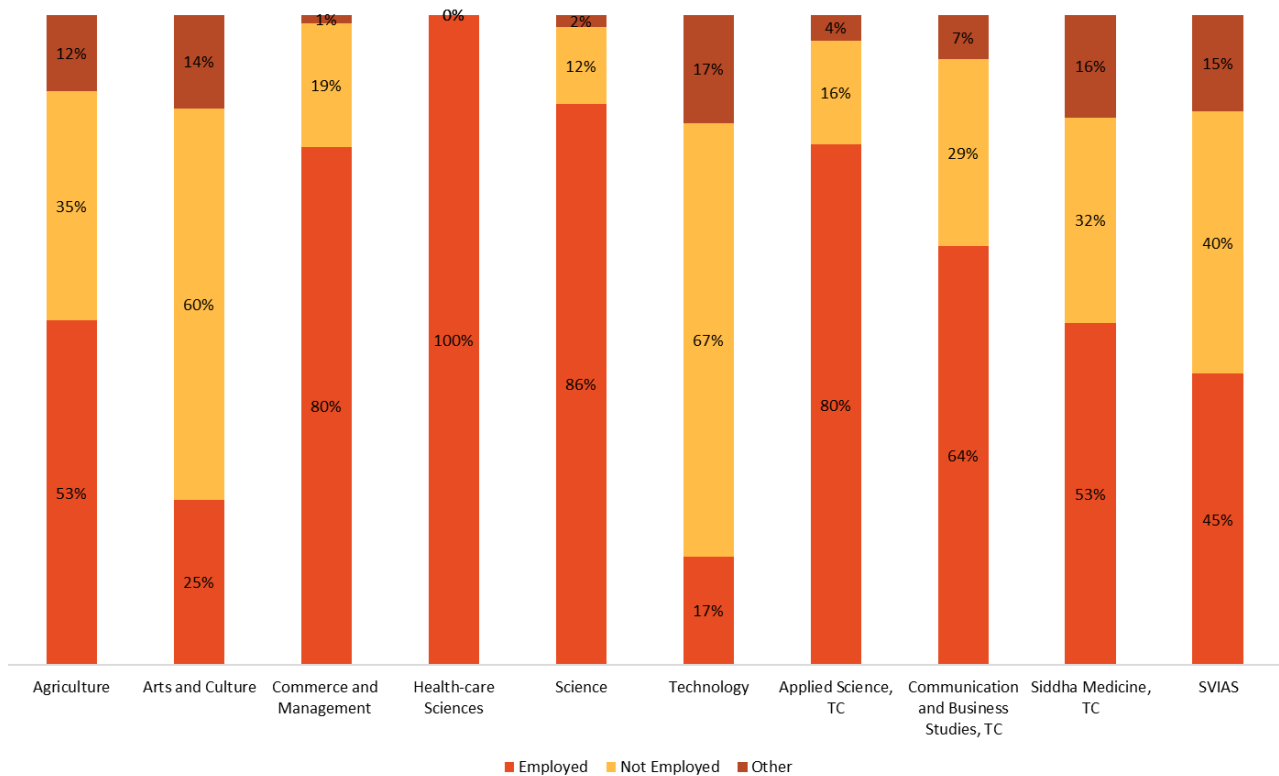
